General Meeting Minutes

The meeting was called to order by President Doug Davis at 7:00 p.m. There being no speaker for this meeting, the committee leaders immediately presented the following reports:

- Programs
 - July – no speaker
 - August – Bob Ott, District 2 Commissioner
 - September – Stephen White, Director/Chief Appraiser, Tax Assessor's Office
- Schools/Legislature – Karen Hallacy
 - Discussions are beginning about next SPLOST for education; the Facilities & Technology Committee will help principals prioritize their need list
 - Walton High School had topping out ceremony
 - New Brumby Elementary and Cobb Middle schools will be built at the same time; new construction bid was put out, saving \$14 million
 - State legislature will be looking into Opportunity School District, which gives the state the ability to take over failing schools
- Meeting Arrangements and Adopt-A-Mile – Helga Hong
 - July 27 general meeting at East Cobb Government Center
 - Next Adopt-A-Mile is July 16 at 9:00 a.m.
- Braves – Marvin Shams
 - Topping out ceremony using an ash tree was held at stadium; construction is on schedule
- Financial Status – Marvin Shams
 - 93 members; \$5,000 positive cash flow; some large expenditures will be coming up soon
- Code Amendments – Jill Flamm
 - ECCA is proposing revisions to sign ordinance, including adding text to Section 134(c) that the provision only applies to properties that conform to the zoning code
- Zonings and Variances – Jill Flamm
 - No zonings for July

- V-87 – Voted to take no action
- V-88 – Voted to recommend denial
- V-90 – Voted to take no action
- V-91 – Voted to recommend denial, with one opposed

- Minutes from the May 25 general meeting were approved

Other Business/Announcements:

- East Cobber Parade, September 17 – ECCA has signed up. We will have a pick-up truck, and all members are welcome to participate.
- On the water main project, there has been a delay in closing Lower Roswell Road at Indian Hills; will finish all the work to the west first.
- Final membership notices have been sent out telling members who have not renewed that they will be dropped from the rolls as of June 30.
